ENGZINE is a student-led literary magazine that celebrates creativity, critical thinking and diverse perspectives. Contributors are encouraged to explore the theme through **poetry, short stories, essays and articles**.

Please note the following submission guidelines:

- All submissions must be original, unpublished and the author's own work.
- Contributors are encouraged to interpret the theme creatively while maintaining academic integrity and literary merit.
- Literary works must not endorse, promote, campaign for, criticise, defame or comment upon any specific regional, national, or international political party, political organisation, elected representative, public office holder or individual associated with any political party or movement.
- Submissions must not contain defamatory, discriminatory, inflammatory, hateful, obscene or unlawful content.
- Contributions should uphold the values of respectful dialogue, responsible expression and intellectual engagement.
- Works that may adversely affect the reputation, academic environment or institutional values of St. Joseph's College (Autonomous), its students, faculty, staff or affiliated communities will not be considered for publication.
- Personal attacks, misinformation, unverified allegations or content that incites hostility or violence are strictly prohibited.
- The Editorial Board reserves the right to decline, edit, or request revisions to any submission that does not comply with the magazine's editorial policies, ethical standards or publication requirements.
- The views expressed in published contributions are those of the respective authors and do not necessarily reflect the views of the Editorial Board, the PG & Research Department of English, or St. Joseph's College (Autonomous).
