Event- 1: Rangoli

Time: 9 a.m. – 10 a.m.

Venue: In Front of FDC

Theme: Statistics in Action: From Data to Decisions

- Individual or **TWO** participants are permitted per team.
- Area allotted 5×5 feet per team.
- Only eco-friendly colours are allowed and participants must bring their own materials.
- *Judgment Criteria:* Creativity, Theme relevance, Neatness, Colour Harmony

Event- 2: Poster Making

Time: 10 a.m. – 11 a.m.

Venue: SAIL Auditorium

Theme: Statistics for Social Development

- Only **ONE** participant is permitted per team.
- Participant must bring their own materials (*colours, brushes, rulers, etc.*).
- Chart paper will be provided; Pre-printed images, stickers, or cut-outs are prohibited.
- *Judgement Criteria:* Theme relevance, Creativity, Visual impact, Artistic quality

Event- 3: Survey Sprint

Time: 9 a.m. – 11 a.m.

Venue: Dept. of Statistics

- Each team may have **TWO** participants, and the topic will be given on the spot.
- Participants must create 8-10 Survey Questions (*may use Google forms & shared 20 participants*)
- Collect the data within the college premises; Bring your own laptop (*Allowed Excel / SPSS / R*).
- Google Form link that will be shared. Upload your One-page summary report (.docx) covering Objective, Method, Data Summary, Graphs, and Key Findings.
- *Judgement Criteria:* Clarity, Methodology, Analysis, Presentation, Insights.

Event- 4: AdZap

Time: 11:30 a.m. - 12 Noon

Venue: SAIL Auditorium

- Team may select their own product. Content that incorporates statistics is preferable.
- Each team is permitted to have **3–5 members**. Time limit 3 minutes per team.
- Background music permitted; Bring your own audio; No offensive, political content allowed.
- *Judgement Criteria:* Creativity, Humour, Team coordination, Over all Presentation.

Event- 5: Quiz

Time: 12 Noon – 1 p.m.

Venue: SAIL Auditorium

- **TWO** participants are permitted per team.
- **Round: 1. Jumble Word** (*Statistics*)
 - Participants will solve word puzzles related to statistical terms.
 - Tests vocabulary, speed, and subject knowledge.
- **Round: 2. General Knowledge**
 - Covers current events, history, science, sports, and culture.
 - Encourages broad awareness and quick recall.
- **Round: 3. Famous Personality** (*Current Affairs*)
 - Identify or answer questions about notable figures in recent news.
 - Focus on leaders, innovators, and celebrities relevant to current times.

General Guidelines:

- There is no registration fee for any event.
- Advance registration is encouraged to ensure smooth coordination.
- Open to all undergraduate and postgraduate students from recognized institutions.
- Participants must carry a valid college ID card.
- A student may participate in multiple events, provided schedules do not clash.
- All participants requested report at least 30 minutes before the start of their event.
- In all, decisions of judges and organizers will be final one.
- Maintain discipline and uphold the spirit of healthy competition.
- Winners and runners-up will be awarded by merit certificates.
- Participation certificates will be issued to all other registered candidates.
- Refreshments will be provided during the Fest.
