STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURE (SOP) FOR STUDENTS

FOR PREVENTIVE MEASURES AGAINST COVID-19

Ensuring the safety of the students is the foremost priority of the college, and the college has extended its services in providing a safe and clean environment. However, the college will not be responsible for any unexpected situations that arise during the COVID 19 pandemic.

Read the instructions on the posters and stickers carefully at the vantage points of the college. Students are requested to follow the guidelines spelt out in the SOP in order to create a safe, secure and COVID-free environment on the campus.

DOS

- Wearing face cover or mask on the way to the college and inside the college premises is mandatory.
- Thermal Scanning facility is available at all the entrances of the college.
- Undergoing the process of thermal scanning is essential before you enter into the college.
- Sanitizer spray available in every department should be used without fail before entering and exiting the department.
- Making regular use of soaps/handwash kept in the restrooms and other stations of the college to clean your hands is expected to become an inevitable practice
- Maintaining physical distancing in the college premises is mandatory.
- Following queue management with reasonable social distancing is expected at all times and all places of the college.
- Maintain social distancing in the classrooms, laboratories and canteen, and in the hallways, corridors and pathways.
- Engaging in fitness activities such as exercise, yoga, and eating healthy food is the responsibility of the students.
- Toilet hygiene is very essential.
- Hostellers are instructed to follow the guidelines strictly.
- It is mandatory for a student to undergo a medical check-up if his/her body temperature is found to be above 38 degree Celsius.
- Installing AROGYASETU APP and the COVID-19 App of the Tamil Nadu Government is essential.

DON'TS

- Avoid crowding at any venue of the college.
- Don't be careless about respiratory etiquettes.
 Don't cough or sneeze without covering your nose and mouth with a kerchief or tissue.
- Spitting is strictly prohibited on the campus.
 Disposal of used masks is to be carefully executed.
- Don't come to the college premises if you have symptoms of COVID-19; also inform the Management if any of your family members are infected with COVID 19.
- Don't come to the college if you are from Containment Zones.
- Avoid exchange of bags, containers, water bottles, hardcopies of study materials, or devices such as mobile phones, chargers, laptops, etc.
- Don't hesitate to seek guidance from the counsellor or the officials if you experience anxiety or depression.
- Don't discriminate students with cold, cough, etc., or with a history of COVID 19.
- Hostellers should avoid going to mess halls in groups.
