**Instructions to Students regarding Offline Classes – 2021-2022**

As per the Press Release (No. 640 dated 21.08.2021) of the Government of Tamilnadu, the college begins Offline classes on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2021. The students are asked to abide by the following guidelines:

- **Offline classes** will be conducted for students of **II PG and III UG**.
- Classes for I PG, I UG and II UG will be conducted online.
- As per the instruction of the Government of Tamilnadu, **ALL** the students who are coming to the college are asked to take COVID-19 Vaccination.
- Students who are NOT vaccinated WILL NOT be allowed to attend offline classes.
- Students are asked to upload their Vaccination Certificate to the Student Portal on the college website on or before 30<sup>th</sup> August 2021.
- Students MUST produce the hardcopy of their COVID-19 Vaccination Certificate when they come to the college for the offline classes.
- Students from Other States NEED NOT attend offline classes. If they want to attend the classes, they have to undergo a 14-day Quarantine in Tamilnadu, and must produce a RT-PCR test stating a COVID NEGATIVE result received within 72 hours before joining the offline class.
- Students with physical disabilities need not attend offline classes.
- Students with fever or other symptoms of COVID-19 MUST NOT attend offline classes.
- Students must undergo thermal scanning at the entrance to the college and other places such as labs, canteen, etc.
- It is compulsory for students to wear masks, sanitize their hands and maintain social distancing in the college premises.
- Students are asked to strictly adhere to all the other instructions presented in the Standing Operating Procedure (SOP). The SOP is displayed in the Student Notice Boards and the website.
