
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
**ST. JOSEPH'S COLLEGE RESEARCH GRANT (SJCRG 2024- 2026)

The main objective of SJCRG is to promote and encourage research culture among the faculty and the Ph D scholars of SJC. Substantial fund will be allocated to potential researchers. Faculty and Ph D scholars are eligible to apply for SJCRG. The guidelines and the application of the SJCRG (2024-2026) are available in the college website. St. Joseph's College Research Grant (SJCRG 2024-2026)
(Institutional Seed Money for Research)

The management of St. Joseph's College is keen to enhance and strengthen quality research among the faculty and the Ph D scholars of St. Joseph's College. In this regard, the management has decided to provide research grant in the form of seed money to faculty and research assistance to Ph D Scholars.

Objectives

- ❖ To inculcate research thrust among the faculty and the Ph D scholars.
- ❖ To achieve quality, original, innovative and socially relevant research publications in reputed journals.
- ❖ To encourage the faculty and research scholars to apply for research grants and file patents.

Details of Research Grant

- ❖ Seed money for faculty will be provided up to Rs. 80,000.
- ❖ Research assistance for Ph D Scholars (Full Time) will be provided up to Rs. 40,000.
- ❖ Only half of the amount will be released initially and the remaining amount will be sanctioned after evaluating the progress.

Guidelines

- ❖ Interested faculty members (both Shift I & II) and Ph D Scholars are asked to submit the proposal along with their curriculum vitae in the given format (can be downloaded from the college website) and present the same on request.
- ❖ Period of Research grant is two years.
- ❖ Faculty members should possess proven research record.
- ❖ Maximum age limit for faculty to apply for the research grant is 50 years and should have completed at least 3 years of teaching at SJC.
- ❖ Proposal from Ph D scholars should be recommended by their respective guides.
- ❖ The budget proposed should be according to the requirements of the research proposal.
- ❖ **The soft copy of the application should reach the Principal on or before 25 October 2023 (college@mail.sjctni.edu) and the hard copy of the same has to reach Dr. A. Anthony Eldred, Dean SCS.**

Expected Outcome


- ❖ The faculty members are expected to publish at least three research articles at the end of the proposed period in Scopus Index Journals, Web of Sciences, SCI Journals, etc. and should have applied for one funded project.
- ❖ Ph. D. Scholars are expected to publish two articles in Scopus Index Journals, Web of Sciences, SCI Journals, etc. and another in UGC-Care listed journal.

OR

- ❖ Three articles in UGC-Care listed journal.
- ❖ The SJC Research Assistance awardees are expected to continue their research in future and mobilize sponsored research grant.

Note:

1. Faculty and Research Scholars who have availed themselves the SJC Research Grant in the past two years need not apply for the grant.
2. Full-time Ph D Scholars who have completed first DC can apply (They should have a minimum period of two years for the submission of their thesis at the time of applying)
