




Dodransbicentennial Jubilee College •

St. Joseph's College established in 1844 by the Society of Jesus, celebrates the 175 years of educational excellence this year. An autonomous institution since 1978, the college had been affiliated to the University of Madras from 1866 and now is to the Bharathidasan University, Tiruchirappalli-24. It was accredited with a **Five Star** status in 2000 by the NAAC and **College with Potential for Excellence** in 2004 by the UGC. The college was reaccredited with A⁺ and A grades by the NACC in 2006 and 2012, respectively. It is the only college in South India with the **Special Heritage Status** recognized by the UGC in 2015, a glorious feather on the crown of the St. Joseph's. The college stands in the 28th position in National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) by the MHRD of India in 2018. Celebrating 175 years of educational excellence this year, the college applies for the fourth cycle of accreditation by the NACC. The College is an alma mater of innumerable eminent personalities like **Dr. A. P. J. Abdul Kalam**.

Chemistry Department ••

Since 1906 the Department of Chemistry, has been catering to the local and global need of chemistry education and research. Eminent personalities such as Sri. N. Gopalswamy, former Chief Election Commissioner of India, Dr. T. Ramasamy, Former Scientific Advisor to the Prime Minister are the proud alumni of our department in the galaxy of illustrious alumni. Awarded with the first best department of the college in 2009, the 111 year old chemistry department offers B.Sc., M.Sc., M.Phil., and Ph.D programmes. Coaching the post graduate chemistry students to crack the eligibility tests such as CSIR-UGC-NET/GATE, and TNSET continues to be a unique feature of the department. Dr. N. Mathiyalagan, Dr. N. Xavier and Dr. S. R. Bheeter were the pioneers of this intensive coaching unit of our department and carried forward the programme successfully for the last two decades. In 2011, under the guidance of Dr. S. Raja, the then HoD, the M. Phil., and Ph. D research scholars of our department and the students and faculty members from other colleges, universities, and NIT-T joined the course and the classes are organized during the weekends and holidays. Recently the students from the neighbouring districts also joined the course. The successful candidates from this coaching programme are now in various reputed academic, and research and development institutions/organizations. Since 2007, the department also prepares the undergraduate chemistry students with two-year intensive coaching to qualify them in the JAM examination and to get admission in the IITs and Central Universities. This coaching is also extended to the neighbouring college students in the recent years.

The First State Level Preparative Workshop (PWC-17) was organized during December 07-09, 2017. Owing to the overwhelming response from the 147 participants from 25 colleges last year, and due to the demand for the highly effective workshop to crack the eligibility tests, we organize the second workshop this year.
